St. Martin's Community College

St. Martin's Community College (SMCC) was started in February 2013 to help the small farmers in particular and the farming sector in general.

SMCC offers training programmes for farmers in collaboration with Government, the Innovative Farming Groups (IFGs) under SMCC and the NGOs operating in the area.

The training interventions are envisaged for small and marginal farmers in Idukki, Kottayam and Pathanamthitta Districts, below 2 Ha of land. Priority will be given to farmers from remote areas so far unreached by services from government departments and other institutions. SMCC is situated in Idukki district. The Kottayam and Pathanamthitta districts are adjoining Idukki district.
